





### BACK TO SCHOOL FUN FACTS

-  \$7.6 billion were spent at family clothing stores for back to school clothing purchases.
-  There are 76 million students - children and adults - enrolled in school throughout the country from nursery school to college. They comprise 27 percent of the entire population 3 and older.
-  67% of students ages 6 to 17 report that they often like school.
-  There are approximately 99,000 public schools and 28,000 private schools.
-  Staying in School has its rewards – the average annual earning of workers 18 and older with a college degree is \$57,181. This compares with \$31, 286 for those with a high school diploma and \$21,484 for those without a high school diploma.
-  There will be a projected 3.3 million high school diplomas awarded in the 2009–10 school year.
